## Nenameseck Fountain

As part of the historic Quaboag Hills region of Massachusetts, land which now makes up the Town of Ware was originally granted to John Read in 1716. It is believed the name of the town was derived from the Native American word "Nenameseck" for the weirs or fish traps that were used at the base of the falls on the Ware River. These same falls were the location of later 18th and 19th century industrial mills.
